Dear Parents and Carers,

It is my privilege to reach out to you one last time, in complete gratitude, and this time, not only on behalf of Central High, but also from me personally.

The last ten years have been nothing short of memorable and I will hold my time here very close to heart.

We have grown here in numbers at Central High, in the last ten years, from 272 learners and now closing in on a strength of 600; from a staff strength of 23 to a team of 56.

We've also grown in terms of our academic achievements - from an average pass rate of 50% in IGCSE, to 90%; and 37% in Sixth Form to 76% currently. An achievement which my team of dedicated teachers has strived to achieve.

We were the first school in Malawi to launch SMARTboard led teaching-learning after rounds of training for our teachers.

We also were able to successfully arrange for Cambridge face-to-face training sessions for our teaching staff on different subjects.



These gave us the confidence to also introduce new subjects into our curriculum, at both IGCSE and A Levels - **Drama, Global Perspectives, Physical Education, Marine Science, Travel and Tourism**, to name the few we have started with.

Two other feathers in our cap have been the introduction of **Pearson BTEC at A Level** last academic year and the **Duke of Edinburgh International Award** later this academic year.

In addition we have had numerous tie-ups with acclaimed universities nationally and internationally, including **Canada, USA, the Middle East, South East Asia and Europe**. We are certain that Central High will continue to flourish and achieve under these collaborations.

It is my pleasure and honour to have had the opportunity to lead Central High International School through these years and give in my humble contribution towards the school's growth. I believe it is time to pass the responsibility on to trustworthy shoulders, to carry forward the school's legacy and take it to greater heights. I firmly believe that the school will continue to grow and shine and that our learners will go on to become successful, motivated individuals who will bring us pride.
